



CALL FOR PAPERS

IEEE, the world's largest technical professional organization dedicated to advancing technology for humanity, and the IEEE Ultrasonics, Ferroelectrics, and Frequency Control Society (UFFC-S) today announced a call for papers for Latin America Ultrasonics Symposium being held virtually on October 4th and 5th.

The first IEEE Latin America Ultrasonics Symposium aims to reinforce existing networking opportunities and to promote emerging networking opportunities to the ultrasonics engineering community in Latin America in connection with other parts of the world. Abstract should be submitted according to the guidelines available on the conference website. The accepted abstracts describing novel research will be eligible to submit a full paper to be published by IEEE Xplore. Original papers in the field of ultrasonics are solicited from the following list of topics:

- » Biomedical ultrasonics
- » Clinical ultrasound
- » Nondestructive evaluation
- » Industrial applications

- » Transducers, sensors, and actuators
- » Physical Acoustics
- » Acoustofluidics

Abstracts reviewing the scientific activities of research groups within Latin America are also welcome.

The Symposium program will include plenary sessions, peer-reviewed paper sessions, and exciting networking activities. A full oral session will be dedicated to a student paper competition.
