# Program Overview

- UFFC Professional Mentorship Program
  - 6 months program – round 1 (3/2021-9/2021); round 2 (11/2021-5/2022)
    - <https://ieee-uffc.org/mentorship-networking/>
    - Workshop materials, recordings, member profiles etc..
  - Participants are matched based on their career stages, technical areas and goals
  - Mentors/mentees meet periodically over the duration of the program
  - Monthly workshops to guide mentoring experience
  - The program is open to all conference attendees during registration (IUS, IFCS, ISAF)
  - We hope the UFFC mentorship program will grow to accommodate a greater share of the society's membership

# Pilot Program (03/2021 – 09/2021)

- Paired 64 mentors/mentees
- Mentor and mentee meet once a month – mainly Mentee-driven
- Monthly webinars to guide mentoring experience
- Surveys at the middle and end of program
- A virtual celebration with all mentor-mentees at IUS 2021
- A certification from IEEE UFFC
