### Program Overview

- UFFC Professional Mentorship Program
  - 6 months program round 1 (3/2021-9/2021); round 2 (11/2021-5/2022)
    - https://ieee-uffc.org/mentorship-networking/
    - Workshop materials, recordings, member profiles etc..
  - Participants are matched based on their career stages, technical areas and goals
  - Mentors/mentees meet periodically over the duration of the program
  - Monthly workshops to guide mentoring experience
  - The program is open to all conference attendees during registration (IUS, IFCS, ISAF)
  - We hope the UFFC mentorship program will grow to accommodate a greater share of the society's membership



Pilot Program (03/2021 - 09/2021)

- Paired 64 mentors/mentees
- Mentor and mentee meet once a month mainly Mentee-driven
- Monthly webinars to guide mentoring experience
- Surveys at the middle and end of program
- A virtual celebration with all mentor-mentees at IUS 2021
- A certification from IEEE UFFC




















# Program Round 2 (11/2021 - 05/2022)

- Pairing (Himanshu & team)
  - 170 mentors/mentees
  - ~100 unpaired mentees (we need more mentors)
  - ~200 showed interests to know more (we have followed up);
  - Mentors/mentees from round 1 are welcome to continue
- Future rounds matching algorithm
  - Suggestions from matching algorithm
    - Career stage, technical area, goals, geographic location etc..
  - Mentee can choose from the talent pool
  - Mentor can confirm the matching
- Infrastructure
  - Sign up available during the conference registrations
  - Webpage + communication portal
    - Portal new features: team info, threads, channels, discussions, team members and search
  - Talent pool in all technical fields
  - Numerous career workshops (new topics are welcome)
